The Lord asked us to practise hospitality and kindness. By learning to serve others we will find life. Let us, then, follow Jesus and live the new life.

1st Reading 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16 - A simple act of hospitality reaps a great reward.

2nd Reading Romans 6:3-4, 8-11 - To be joined to Christ means that we have died and risen to new life.

Gospel Matthew 10:37-42 - The teaching of Jesus. Life begins where selfishness ends. Simple kindness reaps a great reward.

MESSAGE FROM FR. PETER: This Saturday 8th July we look forward to a wonderful moment in the history of St. Joseph's and St. Peter's: The Ordination of David Pope to the Sacred Diaconate. The role of a Parish Deacon is threefold: The Ministry of Charity, serving the poor, vulnerable and marginalised; The Ministry of the Word, proclaiming the Gospel at Mass and other religious services, as well as leading the community in prayer, and; The Ministry of the Altar, assisting the Bishop or Priest at Mass, distributing Holy Communion, and helping in Sacramental Preparation. First and foremost, however, a Deacon is a man of faith, with a desire to serve others for the sake of God and his Kingdom. After several years of training, and placements in other parishes in the Diocese, the Bishop will lay his hands on David and pray that he is, 'strengthened by the Gift of Your sevenfold grace, to carry out faithfully the work of the ministry... May he excel in every virtue, in love that is sincere, in concern for the sick and the poor, in unassuming authority, in self-discipline, and in holiness of life... and imitate Christ who came, not to be served but to serve, and one day reign with him in heaven'. Let us make that our prayer for David in his final week of preparation, and pledge him our prayers and support for the years to come, grateful for his response to the calling of the Lord to serve Him, and us, in Lytham and Ansdell and in the Diocese of Lancaster.

David's Ordination Next Saturday: We have 2 buses leaving the parishes on Saturday for those who have signed up. The first pick up will be at **St. Peter's at 11am**. The second pick up at St. Joseph's at 11.15am. Please bring your £10 with you to be collected on the bus. If you are NOT at the pickup points at these times we will have to assume you are not coming. We are aiming to be in Lancaster for 12.15pm, giving time to depart the buses and use toilets at the Cathedral before taking our seats, ready for the **Mass of Ordination at 1pm**. There will be light refreshments after the Mass in the Cathedral Social Centre. We will depart Lancaster at approximately 4.15pm.
