# On Thursday 8th September we celebrate the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary

More than 2000 years ago there dwelt in the little Galilean village of Nazareth a holy couple of the royal race of David, whose names were Ann and Joachim. They were already far advanced in years, and had almost ceased to hope that God would bless them with a child, when the long-felt desire of their hearts was gratified by the birth of a daughter, who would be forever blessed among women and make the names of Ann and Joachim known and honoured through all future ages. This child was called Mary, the chosen one of Adam's race, destined to be the Mother of Jesus Christ, Who became her child, to redeem and save the world.

Eight days after the birth of the Blessed Virgin, her holy parents, inspired by God, gave her the name of Mary. Just to say her holy name is a prayer.

## **RELICS OF ST. BERNADETTE**

When the Diocese of Lancaster was drawn up in 1924 by Pope Pius XI, the patron saints chosen for the new diocese were St Cuthbert (c634-687) and Our Lady of Lourdes. Since 1858, when the apparitions at Lourdes began, Lourdes has become firmly establish as a place of love, devotion and healing amongst people of faith. The humble young woman to whom the Mother of God appeared in these apparitions was Bernadette Soubirous (1844-1879). The Diocese, between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> September, has the opportunity to be close to some Relics of St Bernadette, and through them, to experience the powerful intercession of this humble woman firstly in Lancaster and then Carlisle.
