BLESSED JUAN DIEGO (Layman)

Thursday 9th December

Little is known about the life of Juan Diego to whom Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared on December 9th, 1531. His given name was said to be "Cuauhtlatoatzin" (meaning "talking Eagle" in his native language).

He was a member of the Chichimeca people, one of the more culturally advanced groups living in the Valley of Anahuac, as the area that is now Mexico City was once known. He was a leader of his own people and may have been involved in the area's textile industry.

After the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary, according to tradition, Juan Diego received the Bishop's permission to live as a hermit in a small hut near the chapel that was built on Tepeyac. There he cared for the church and the first pilgrims who came to see the miraculous image and pray to the Mother of Jesus.
