ST. MATTHIAS

Friday 14th May

St Matthias was born in Judea and was, according to the Acts of the Apostles, chosen by the apostles to replace Judas Iscariot following the latter's betrayal of Jesus and his subsequent death.

Matthias was the only apostle not appointed directly by Jesus Himself, but was selected by the Apostles with a secret ballot.

While little is known about Matthias, it is known he was present for all of Jesus' ministry from his Baptism to the Resurrection, and to the Ascension. Matthias was an eyewitness of these events and this would eventually lead to him being qualified for candidacy as an Apostle.

He died 80 AD in Jerusalem.
