We come together to celebrate the Mass, celebrating the kingship of Jesus and his humility and gentleness to all people and especially his understanding of the blessings of children.

1st Reading Zechariah 9:9-10 - The prophet Zechariah presents the vision of a Messiah. It is a king riding on a donkey and proclaiming peace for all nations.

2nd Reading Romans 8:9, 11-13 - The Spirit of God lives in each one of us, and attention must be paid to the spiritual dimension in our lives.

Gospel Matthew 11:25-30 - Those who are well informed and arrogant in their knowledge can easily miss what God is really telling us. Children can sometimes more easily relate to the teachings of a God who is "gentle and humble of heart".

MESSAGE FROM FR. PETER: So what an historic weekend this is in the Parishes of St. Peter's and St. Joseph's, to celebrate the Ordination of Deacon David. As Clergy and Parishioners, we are truly blessed. There'll be more on David's Ordination next week, but this Sunday he will celebrate his first Rosary, Sermon and Benediction at St. Peter's this Sunday afternoon at 3pm., a chance for us all to come together in a spirit of thanksgiving, but also to celebrate, as I outlined last week, some of the dedicated ministry of the Deacon. Firstly, Deacon David will lead us in prayer, as we celebrate together the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary, which themselves tell us of the life-giving public ministry of Jesus upon this earth. David will then preach his first homily, breaking open the Word of God for our spiritual edification. And finally, leading Solemn Benediction, Deacon David will demonstrate his third ministry; to the Altar and to the Eucharistic Presence, calling us to bow and worship before God's greatest gift of Himself. A fitting end to the beginning of Deacon David's Diaconal ministry. Please do gather for the service at 3pm at St. Peter's after which we will have celebration of fellowship in the hall, with scones and tea.
