HOW TO MAKE A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Desire, with earnest longing, to receive our Lord present — Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity — in the Blessed Sacrament, say this prayer of St. Alphonsus de' Ligouri:

"My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire You in my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

As though You are already there, I embrace You and unite myself wholly to You; do not let me ever be separated from You.
