We come together today to celebrate the memorial of Christ's life, death and rising again. We receive the body and blood of Christ, the bread of everlasting life.

1st Reading Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16 - Moses reminds his people that they owe everything to God who led them out of slavery and provided for them in the wilderness.

2nd Reading 1 Corinthians 10:16-17 - In the sacrificial meal, participants become united with God and each other. **Gospel John 6:51-58** - The very life of Christ is presented to his followers as food and drink.

MESSAGE FROM FR. PETER: Well Eastertide ended on the Feast of Pentecost a couple of weeks ago, and we entered the green-vestmented 'Ordinary time' of the Church's year. Last Sunday we were still celebrating Feasts, though, with the lovely celebration of the Mystery of the Trinity, and having rejoiced at having one God who is Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, this Sunday we celebrate the body of Christ, made present by the Holy Spirit, in the will of the Father. This weekend is Corpus Christi. We celebrate, in a sense, what it is a privilege and gift to celebrate every week, in fact every day; The Eucharistic presence of Christ in Holy Communion. Paul VI wrote the following prayer which is a plea for the intercession of Mary that all Churches might one day be able to share the Eucharist together, but today we might also pray for ourselves first of all, that the Lord will deepen our belief, faith and trust in his body and blood: May the most blessed Virgin Mary, from whom Christ the Lord took the flesh that "is contained, offered, received" in this Sacrament under the appearances of bread and wine, and may all the saints of God and especially those who were more inflamed with ardent devotion toward the divine Eucharist, intercede with the Father of mercies so that this common belief in the Eucharist and devotion to it may give rise among all Christians to a perfect unity of communion that will continue to flourish... fortified by the most consoling hope of blessings that will accrue to the whole Church and to the whole world from an increase in devotion to the Eucharist, as a pledge of heavenly blessings.
