RELICS OF ST. BERNADETTE

When the Diocese of Lancaster was drawn up in 1924 by Pope Pius XI, the patron saints chosen for the new diocese were St Cuthbert (c634-687) and Our Lady of Lourdes. Since 1858, when the apparitions at Lourdes began, Lourdes has become firmly establish as a place of love, devotion and healing amongst people of faith. The humble young woman to whom the Mother of God appeared in these apparitions was Bernadette Soubirous (1844-1879). The Diocese, between 22nd and 24th September, has the opportunity to be close to some Relics of St Bernadette, and through them, to experience the powerful intercession of this humble woman firstly in Lancaster and then Carlisle. Wednesday 14th September Feast of the Exultation of the Holy Cross

When the Sacred Body of Jesus was taken down from the Cross and carried to the tomb on Calvary, the Cross on which He died was thrown into a ditch or well, and covered over with stones and earth, so that the followers of the Crucified Redeemer might not find it.

In 326, St. Helena - Mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine - set out on a pilgrimage to Jerusalem to find the True Cross. During excavation work, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman. The feast of the Triumph of the Holy Cross is the sign of our salvation.
