St Teresa of Jesus (October 15)

St. Teresa was born on 28th March, 1515, in Avila, Spain. Her mother died when she was 12 and her father placed her in a convent of Augustinian nuns. When she returned home, she determined to enter religion. She became a nun in the Carmelite Convent of the Incarnation, and made her profession in November 1534.

Inspired by the Holy Spirit she undertook the superhuman task of reforming her Order, assisted by St. John of the Cross. She wrote many books on Mystical Theology and in 1970, Pope Paul VI added her to the role of the Doctors of the Church.
