St. Anthony of Padua, Priest & Doctor of the Church

June 13th - Patron of the Poor

St. Anthony, called "St Anthony of Padua" on account of his long residence in that city, was a native of Lisbon in Portugal, where he was born in 1195, receiving the name of Ferdinand at his Baptism. At an early age his parents placed him in the community of the Canons of the Cathedral of Lisbon, by whom he was educated. At 15 he entered the Order of Regular Canons of St. Augustine near Lisbon. After 2 years he was sent to the convent of the Holy Cross of the same Order at Coimbra.

He had lived in this house 8 years when the relics of 5 Franciscan martyrs were brought from Morocco to Portugal. This event inspired him to follow in the footsteps of these heroes of the Faith. When this became known, his brethren offered extreme opposition, but he finally obtained the consent of the prior and passed over to the Franciscan Order.

Though he was denied the grace of a martyr's death, St. Anthony was a martyr of the Word, he was an accomplished orator, being at the same time filled with zeal for souls. So numerous were those who flocked to hear him that no church could house them and the saint was often forced to preach in the open air. He was regarded as a legendary hero and striking miracles were related about him. He died 13th June 1231.

The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.
