Sacrament of Reconciliation with Exposition: Monday 9:30-10am at St. Peter's.

This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday, when we especially remember all those who died in the Two World Wars, and all who have died in acts of warfare and violence whilst serving their country, and those who still continue to die amidst the bloodshed and violence which still blights our world. Deacon David will represent us at the Memorial Service in Lytham, and at all our masses this weekend we will celebrate the following Act of Remembrance.

Priest: Let us remember before God, and commend to his sure keeping:

those who have died for their country in war;

those whom we knew, and whose memory we treasure;

and all who have lived and died in the service of mankind.

#### Reader:

They shall grow not old as we that are left grow old:

age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning

we will remember them. All: We will remember them.

Here follows The Silence. Then the Last Post is sounded.

Priest: Almighty and eternal God,

from whose love in Christ we cannot be parted,

neither by death nor life:

hear our prayers and thanksgivings for all whom we remember this day;

fulfil in them the purpose of your love;

and bring us all, with them, to your eternal joy;

through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

**THIS WEEK'S READINGS:** Jesus calls us to live for him and to serve him every day. In our worship today we make ourselves ready to welcome him into our lives once again.

**1st Reading Wisdom 6:12-16** - We are encouraged to seek God's wisdom and we are promised that it will sustain and guide us at all times.

**2nd Reading 1** *Thessalonians* **4:13-18** - Paul reassures us that both those who have died in the past, and those who are alive when Christ returns, will be gathered together in heaven.

**Gospel Matthew 25:1-13** - Jesus contrasts people who prepare for his return with those who do not, and shows that only those who are ready can share fully in the joy he brings.
