STS. CYRIL & METHODIUS - 14th February

The two brothers, Apostles of the Slavs, were born in Thessalonica 826 & 827, and educated at Constantinople. After St. Cyril had preached in southern Russia, they were sent by the Patriarch St. Ignatius as missionaries to the Bulgarians, whom they soon converted to Christianity. Then they extended their work into Moravia & Dalmatia.

When they came to Rome to render an account of their mission, they were consecrated Bishops to Pope Hadrian II. St Cyril died in Rome in 869 leaving St. Methodius to continue the apostolate alone. St. Methodius died in April 883, worn out by his heroic labours and long struggles with enemies that never ceased to antagonise him. The relics of both brothers are venerated in the church of St. Clement in Rome.
