ST. RICHARD OF CHICHESTER- BISHOP

Wednesday 16th June

Richard of Chichester, was Bishop of Chichester. In Chichester Cathedral a shrine dedicated to Richard had become a richly decorated centre of pilgrimage. In 1538, during the reign of Henry VIII, the shrine was plundered and destroyed by order of Thomas Cromwell.

Saint Richard was a man of strong character and a scholar, he loved people and was greatly beloved by them.

The miracle for which Richard is chiefly known is that of the overturned chalice. The story tells that Richard, tired and ill from his labours, was celebrating mass and dropped the chalice containing the consecrated wine. Amazingly none was spilled!

The 3rd of April is the feast of St Richard but is not recognised in the universal Roman Calendar, the translation of St. Richard is celebrated at Chichester Cathedral on 16th June because the feast of St. Richard invariably falls in Lent or Eastertide. He died in 1253 and was canonized in 1262 by Pope Urban IV.

St. Richard's Prayer on his Deathbed:

Thanks be to you, my lord, Jesus Christ, For all the benefits that you have given me; For all the pains and insults you have borne for me.

O, most merciful redeemer, friend and brother,
May I know you more clearly;
Love you more dearly;
And follow you more nearly.
