Monday 14th September Feast of the Exultation of the Holy Cross

When the Sacred Body of Jesus was taken down from the Cross and carried to the grave on Calvary, the Cross on which He died was thrown into a ditch or well, and covered over with stones and earth, so that the followers of the Crucified Redeemer might not find it.

In 326, St. Helena - Mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine - set out on a pilgrimage to Jerusalem to find the True Cross. During excavation work, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman.

The feast of the Triumph of the Holy Cross is the sign of our salvation.
