Did you know.....four years ago, CAFOD launched its first *Hands On* project, in Kitui, Kenya? CAFOD supporters in England and Wales followed the community's progress in Kitui, while sending vital donations, encouragement and prayers. Today, the Kitui community along with CAFOD water specialists have restored the existing failed reservoir, planted thousands of trees, created thousands of metres of terracing and built five sand dams. The community now has access to water for drinking and growing crops; even in the driest periods the reservoir holds enough water for the community. Thanks to your support the people of Kitui in Kenya have achieved so much.

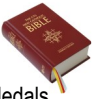
### Broughton Catholic Charitable Society
