100 Centenary John Bradburne 1921 - 2021 Centenary Pilgrimage

Saturday September 11th 2021 from 11am

Come and climb Cross Fell (John Bradburne did), England's highest hill outside the Lake District. Just 5 miles from Skirwith where John Bradburne's earliest years were spent.

The climb and return will take 5-6 hours. Total distance is 12 km and involves a climb of 700m, so some fitness and good boots are recommended but no mountaineering skills are required, there is a path all the way.

St. Pius X, Pope (August 21st)

On June 2nd 1835, Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto saw the light of earth at Riesi, Province of Treviso, in Venice; on August 20th 1914, he saw the light of heaven; and on May 29th 1954, he who had become the 259th Pope was canonized St. Pius X.

One of the most outstanding accomplishments of this saintly Pope was the inauguration of frequent communion from childhood.

His last will and testament bears the striking sentence:

"I was born poor, I have lived in poverty, and I wish to die poor."
