Today we focus on God's constant activity in the world, as through us he sows the seed of his truth in other people's lives. **1st Reading** *Isaiah* **55:10-11 -** When God sends his word into the world, he does so with a purpose that is always achieved. **2nd Reading** *Romans* **8:18-23 -** The whole world is waiting to enjoy the perfect renewal that Jesus Christ came to bring. **Gospel** *Matthew* **13:1-23 -** One of Jesus' best-known parables gives us a task to share in & a promise of his blessing as we do so.

**MESSAGE FROM Deacon David:** WOW what a weekend that was!! I want to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you for your kind words, cards and gifts on the occasion of my ordination as a Deacon, but above all for your prayers. Fr Peter reminded us only the other week of the threefold ministry of a deacon, that of, Word, Altar and Charity.
