**This Week's Readings:** Christ became truly human for us and suffered death to save us. We are called to follow him through death to eternal life.

**1st Reading** *Jeremiah* **31:31-34 -** God promises to place divine love and knowledge in the hearts of his people, so they can receive forgiveness.

**2nd Reading Hebrews 5:7-9** - Jesus is shown pleading on our behalf, and becoming for us the source of eternal life. **Gospel: John 12:20-33** - The hour has come for Jesus to offer himself as a sacrifice, in loving obedience to the Father.

Message from Fr. Newbold: The topic for this week's Lenten talk was 'The Bible'. The books of the Bible, at least 72 of them, are sacred books. All the major religions have their sacred texts which are revered, read, chanted and prayed. Our books of the Bible tells us of the God who created us and the wonderful universe in love. It's the story of saintly men and women as well as people with weakness. To David's dynasty came Jesus, known as the Christ: Jesus the God made visible who speaks to us of the Creator's love, mercy, forgiveness and gentleness. Those who acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God are promised life eternal. How we are excited by the prospect of having purpose in our life and to have our destination assured with the joy of the creator's presence. Have you a modern English Bible, either a hard copy or access on line? More importantly read it and use it for reflection and prayer - especially the Gospels. Father, anoint me with your Holy Spirit, so that as I read your eternal word, your word may penetrate my whole being and transform me. Grant me the blessing to be a faithful disciple in believing the Word of God and that I may be a light shining upon all who are in darkness. Amen.
