As you will have no-doubt heard, Fr David is to move to St Bernadette's in Bispham in September at the request of Bishop Paul Swarbrick. Fr Peter Clarke, from St Bernadette's, will be coming to replace him. Bishop Paul Swarbrick announced some changes for the two parishes to work more closely together in his Pastoral Letter last weekend:

- 1. One newsletter between the two parishes
- 2. One parish advisory council at the discretion of the parish priest
- 3. A timetable of liturgies throughout the year, including Christmas and Easter, between the two Parishes, removing the necessity of bringing in other clergy or the adaptation of Mass times.
- 4. The 5.05pm Sunday evening Mass at St Joseph's to cease at the end of July.
