ST. LUKE, EVANGELIST - October 18th

St. Luke was born in Antioch, Syria, he was a Gentile by birth and a physician by profession. He became the missionary companion of St. Paul. The Church ascribes the 3rd Gospel to St. Luke - it shows that its author was a person of literary powers, a physician, and a companion of St. Paul. In his Gospel there is a steady movement of events from Nazareth to Jerusalem, whereas in the Acts it is from Jerusalem to Rome.

GIFT AID

Recently we received the tax refunds on Gift Aided contributions for the financial year 2020/21. The Parish account was credited with £9398.52 and the Overseas Mission account with £745.38. These amounts are only fractionally lower than those for the previous year. From that you will gather that despite the church closure during 'lockdown' and reduced capacity for the remainder of the year, your Gift Aid contributions (envelopes, standing orders and online) were maintained at just about the same level as the previous year. This was an excellent achievement and a testimony to your loyalty to St Peter's parish and to your wonderful generosity. THANK YOU!

Although the Gift Aid contributions were maintained at the previous year's level, the pandemic had the effect of reducing the total Offertory collection by £5821 when compared with the previous year. Although many of our non Gift Aiders also sent in their contributions during 'lockdown', for which we are most grateful - THANK YOU !, we did miss out on the 'loose collection' from visitors and people from other parishes who come to St Peter's from time to time.

STREETLIFE BIG SLEEPOUT 2021

On Friday 1st October team Elston (Mike, Joe & Dan) slept rough for one night to raise money for **Streetlife**. We've been associated with Streetlife for a number of years and Mike is a member of their organising committee.

Streetlife supports vulnerable young people in Blackpool with its support hub and night shelter. Due to the enormous generosity of its supporters, Streetlife raised a whopping £43k from 2019's Big Sleepout. This money was used to provide emergency safe accommodation to homeless your people in the Streetlife Night Shelter at St John's Walk in Blackpool town centre. Unfortunately the pandemic has hampered fund raising activities and there was no Sleepout in 2020. At the same time the need for Streetlife's services remains as acute as ever.
