1st Reading *Isaiah 7:10-14* The future Incarnation is prophesied through Isaiah. God will come and dwell with his people.

2nd Reading *Romans* **1:1-7** Paul writes to the Romans, telling them that Jesus is both fully human and fully divine.

Gospel Matthew 1:18-24 The prophecy is fulfilled as Mary conceives, and God is born into a real human family.

Christmas Mass A

In the quiet of this night a child is born. Into the darkness of this world a saviour comes. Let us gather round this child and welcome the Lord of life.

1st Reading *Isaiah 9:1-7* Isaiah, the prophet, describes the ideal king of Israel, a ruler who is wise and just, a prince of peace. **2nd Reading** *Titus 2:11-14* Paul tells us what the birth of Jesus means - that salvation and holiness are possible for the whole human race.

Gospel Luke 2:1-14 Luke describes the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem and how glory shone down upon the world.
