**OUR LADY OF FERNYHALGH - 25th June**

Fernyhalgh or Ladyewell has been a place of pilgrimage and devotion for many centuries with a continuity through times of persecution through to the present day. Pilgrimages from Salford, Liverpool and Lancaster have taken place over the years, as well as many other gatherings for prayer. Today it is a special place for the memory of our local martyrs as well as the devotion to Our Blessed Lady. This day gives us an opportunity to give thanks for the witness of faith which has been handed down to us to be lived with faithfulness and love.

**ST. ALOYSIUS GONZAGA, RELIGIOUS  
June 21st**

St. Aloysius was born at Castiglione in the diocese of Brescia, 9th March, 1568. From his tenderest years he devoted himself heart and soul to the service of his Creator. At 14 years of age he accompanied his father to Spain, where the latter went to attend the Empress, Maria of Austria, wife of Maximilian II. On his return to Italy in 1584, he manifested his desire to enter the Society of Jesus. In spite of opposition, he finally succeeded in carrying out his intentions and became a novice at Rome in 1585, during the pontificate of Pope Pius V. He made his profession on 20th November 1587.

During an epidemic in Rome in 1591, St. Aloysius distinguished himself by his charity toward the sick in the hospital. These labours brought on him the illness that ended in his death. His last days were the faithful echo of his briefly consummated life. He exchanged time for eternity on 21st June, 1591, at 24 years of age and was canonized by Benedict XIII in 1726.
