MESSAGE FROM FR PETER:

It was beautiful to celebrate Remembrance Sunday last week in our own way, with our Acts of Remembrance at each of our Masses; many people commented how moving it was to hear the strains of the Last Post following The Silence, reminding us all how we have so many, and so much, to be grateful for. I also, this week, celebrated my first Requiem Mass down here; a reminder to us all of our corporal work of mercy in caring, and praying for, the deceased, not least in their month of November.
