RELICS OF ST. BERNADETTE

When the Diocese of Lancaster was drawn up in 1924 by Pope Pius XI, the patron saints chosen for the new diocese were St Cuthbert (c634-687) and Our Lady of Lourdes. Since 1858, when the apparitions at Lourdes began, Lourdes has become firmly establish as a place of love, devotion and healing amongst people of faith. The humble young woman to whom the Mother of God appeared in these apparitions was Bernadette Soubirous (1844-1879). The Diocese, between 22nd and 24th September, has the opportunity to be close to some Relics of St Bernadette, and through them, to experience the powerful intercession of this humble woman firstly in Lancaster and then Carlisle. BLESSED DOMINIC BARBERI OF THE MOTHER OF GOD (27th August)

Bl. Dominic Barberi was an Italian theologian and a member of the Passionist Congregation prominent in spreading Catholicism.

He was born near Viterbo to a poor family of Italian farmers in 1792 - as a boy he was employed to take care of sheep He became acquainted with several Passionists living in exile near his town, he befriended them and served daily Mass with them.

He was received into the Congregation of the Passion in 1814 and believed that he was called to preach the Gospel in far off lands and received a specific call to preach to the people of England. Dominic and a companion went to England and opened a house at Aston Hall in Staffordshire.

In August 1849, Dominic was travelling to Worcester from London. About 5 miles from Reading, Dominic got desperately sick. He died from a heart attack at 3pm on the 27th August 1849.
