**100 Centenary John Bradburne 1921 - 2021**

**Centenary Pilgrimage**

**Saturday September 11th 2021 from 11am**

Come and climb Cross Fell (John Bradburne did), England's highest hill outside the Lake District. Just 5 miles from Skirwith where John Bradburne's earliest years were spent.

The climb and return will take 5-6 hours. Total distance is 12 km and involves a climb of 700m, so some fitness and good boots are recommended but no mountaineering skills are required, there is a path all the way.

**ST. ROSE OF LIMA - August 23rd**

Isabel De Flores Y Del Oliva, called Rose by her mother because of her red cheeks and confirmed with that name by St. Turibius, was the first person in the Americas to be canonized as a saint. Born in Lima, Peru, in 1586, she worked long and hard to help support her family, growing flowers and doing embroidery and other needlework.

At twenty years of age she became a Dominican Tertiary and lived in a summerhouse in the garden of her home. Here she practiced extreme penance and mortification, modelling her life after that of St. Catherine of Siena. She is regarded as the originator of social service in Peru. She died in 1617 at thirty-one years of age.
