THIS WEEK'S READINGS: We are called by name to be heralds of the kingdom of God. Today the Lord challenges our understanding of generosity, inviting us to make God's ways our ways and God's thoughts our thoughts.

1st Reading Isaiah 55:6-9 - God's ways are as high above our ways, as the heavens are above earth.

2nd Reading *Philippians* 1:20-24, 27 - Avoid anything in daily life that is unworthy of the gospel of Christ.

Gospel Matthew 20:1-16 - The parable of the vineyard teaches us the radical inclusiveness of God's kingdom where the first will be last and the last will be first.

MESSAGE FROM FATHER PETER: Several of the Prefaces to the Eucharistic prayers at mass conclude, '...with Angels and Archangels, with Thrones and Dominions, and with all the host and powers of heaven...'. Well, this Friday, 29th we have the Feast of the Archangels, Michael, Gabriel and Raphael. St. Michael's name means 'one who is like God' and he is venerated as captain of the heavenly army, victor over Satan, protector of the Church and helper of sick and dying. St. Gabriel, whose name means 'strength of God' announced both the birth of St. John the Baptist to Zechariah, and that of Jesus Christ to Mary at the Annunciation, and also to the Shepherds, giving us the 'Angelic Salutation'. And St. Raphael, whose name means 'God heals' took care of Tobias (the biblical figure, not the presbytery cat) on his journey as described in the book of Tobit. He is patron Saint of the blind, travellers, and physicians and nurses. So that's the Archangels, what about the rest? Well 'the rest'; are other categories of angels, of which there are actually nine, divided into three: the Highest, Seraphim (closest to god), Cherubim (the noble), Thrones (who watch over the cosmos); the Middle, Dominions (which govern earthly nations), Virtues (governing blessings and miracles, and those struggling with faith), and Powers (those first created, who watch how earthly power is used); and the lowest, Principalities (concerned with earthly authority), Archangels, and finally all other hosts of Angels, including our beloved Guardian Angels. Jesus said, 'I tell you, there is rejoicing in presence of the Angels of God over one sinner who repents.' Let's give all those Angels plenty of cause for rejoicing! In other news, After God created 24 hours of alternating light and darkness, one of the angels asked him, 'What are you going to do now?' God said, 'I think I might just call it a day'. I'll get my coat. And my wings.
