SERVANT OF GOD ELIZABETH PROUT

Elizabeth Prout, Mother Mary Joseph of Jesus CP was the Foundress of the Sisters of the Cross and Passion. On 2nd September of this year we celebrate the bicentenary of her birth. She converted from Anglicanism to Catholicism between 1842 and 1848 after Blessed Dominic Barberi CP had arrived to found the first Passionist Retreat in England at Stone, Staffordshire where she lived. She was later asked to take a post as schoolmistress at St Chad's girls' school in Manchester. She was asked to co-operate with the parish priest there and Fr Gaudentius Rossi CP in the of a new Congregation providing contemplative and active religious life for women. She founded the Sisters of the Cross and Passion Congregation at St Chad's, Cheetham Manchester on 21st November 1852. She died in 1864, just nine years before the Sisters came here to Lytham. Her remains are in a sepulchre, as are those of Servant of God Fr Ignatius Spencer CP, at the side of the tomb of Blessed Dominic Barberi in St Anne Blessed Dominic Barberi Church in Sutton, St Helens, There will be a Pilgrimage Mass there for the bicentenary of Mother Mary Joseph's birth at Noon on 26th September.
