STS. PETER AND PAUL APOSTLES -

June 29th - Holy Day of Obligation

ST. PETER was a fisherman of Galilee, named Simon, and the son of John. His brother Andrew introduced him to Christ. Christ changed his name to Peter (Rock) and made him the Rock on which His Church was to be built. After His Resurrection, Jesus conferred the primacy on Peter and he became the Vicar of Christ and the head of the Apostles, the first Pope. St. Peter dwelt in Rome intermittently for 25 years as founder and first Bishop of the Church there. Finally, in the last year of Nero's reign, 67, he was crucified with his head downward, at his own request, not deeming himself worthy to die as did his Divine Master.

ST. PAUL, the indefatigable Apostle of the Gentiles, was converted from Judaism on the road to Damascus. He remained some days in Damascus after his Baptism and then went to Arabia, to prepare himself for his future missionary activity. Having returned to Damascus, by preaching in the synagogues that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, he incurred the hatred of the Jews and had to flee from the city. He then went to Jerusalem to see Peter and pay his homage to the head of the Church. He travelled extensively and after two years imprisonment at Caesarea he finally reached Rome where he was kept another two years in chains. When released from imprisonment he then travelled to Spain, later to the East again and then back to Rome, where he was imprisoned a second time, and in the year 67 was beheaded. The centuries only make more apparent his greatness of mind and spirit.
