RELICS OF ST. BERNADETTE

When the Diocese of Lancaster was drawn up in 1924 by Pope Pius XI, the patron saints chosen for the new diocese were St Cuthbert (c634-687) and Our Lady of Lourdes. Since 1858, when the apparitions at Lourdes began, Lourdes has become firmly establish as a place of love, devotion and healing amongst people of faith. The humble young woman to whom the Mother of God appeared in these apparitions was Bernadette Soubirous (1844-1879). The Diocese, between 22nd and 24th September, has the opportunity to be close to some Relics of St Bernadette, and through them, to experience the powerful intercession of this humble woman firstly in Lancaster and then Carlisle. STS. MARGARET CLITHEROW, ANNE LINE, MARGARET WARD

Martyrs - 30th August

This day commemorates the three canonised women martyrs of the English Reformation. All three were declared Venerable on 8th December 1929 by Pope Pius XI, and canonized on 25th October 1970 by Pope Paul VI among the Forty Martyrs of England & Wales.

Margaret Clitherow, for harbouring fugitive priests, was condemned and pressed to death on 25th March 1586.

Anne Line was tried, convicted and hanged for harbouring priests on 27th February 1601 at Tyburn, London.

Margaret Ward was arrested for helping Fr Richard Watson escape from Bridewell Prison. Imprisoned, she was offered freedom if she would surrender Fr Watson but she declined. She was hanged, drawn and quartered on 30th August 1588 at Tyburn.
