David has been in formation for ordination to the diaconate. Last Saturday he received Candidacy from Bishop Paul Swarbrick at the cathedral, that is to say, he has been accepted as a worthy candidate to proceed with his preparation for ordination. This has involved David in studying theology: a deeper understanding of what the Church teaches. The bishop has asked that he expand his experience of liturgy and pastoral work by spending time in other parishes. David has been assigned to the parish of Christ the King & St Kentigern in Blackpool. He is still one of our own, and the bishop has asked that the next stage of his progress: institution to the Ministry of Reader be celebrated in his home parish. At the 10.30am Mass next Sunday, Fr David will perform the institution. Please keep David and his family in your prayers.

GIFT AID

Last week we received the tax refunds on Gift Aided contributions for the financial year 2020/21. The Parish account was credited with £9398.52 and the Overseas Mission account with £745.38. These amounts are only fractionally lower than those for the previous year. From that you will gather that despite the church closure during 'lockdown' and reduced capacity for the remainder of the year, your Gift Aid contributions (envelopes, standing orders and online) were maintained at just about the same level as the previous year. This was an excellent achievement and a testimony to your loyalty to St Peter's parish and to your wonderful generosity. THANK YOU!

Although the Gift Aid contributions were maintained at the previous year's level, the pandemic had the effect of reducing the total Offertory collection by £5821 when compared with the previous year. Although many of our non Gift Aiders also sent in their contributions during 'lockdown', for which we are most grateful - THANK YOU !, we did miss out on the 'loose collection' from visitors and people from other parishes who come to St Peter's from time to time.

World Mission Sunday is vital to the growth of the Church and the spread of the Gospel in predominantly impoverished and remote areas overseas. The funds raised build muchneeded infrastructure, from chapels and schools to orphanages, clinics and dispensaries. Requested by the local community, the support from Missio transforms lives and creates a hub from which the young Church can flourish and grow. World Mission Sunday is one of only three Papal collections and has been especially chosen by the Holy Father to support the mission of the Church in the world via Missio.

World Mission Sunday is celebrated in every Catholic community in the world. It is a time of grace to express solidarity with our brothers and sisters in Christ who are living in situations of poverty, violence and oppression.

The theme the Holy Father has chosen this year is:

"We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard" (Acts 4:20).
