UPDATE FROM GEMMA REGARDING PHOEBE'S TREATMENT

"Phoebe had surgery at Birmingham Children's Hospital on Monday (23rd Aug) to remove the tumour in her leg and replace it with a prosthesis. She went into surgery at 9.30am holding the little olive-wood cross given to her by Father David, and the rosary beads from Adrian - she was out in Recovery by 2.30pm! The surgeons who performed the operation said that "the tumour came away beautifully" and they were very pleased with how surgery went.

Since then Phoebe has been bed-bound but able to do some physio which shows the nerves in her leg haven't been affected as she is able to move her ankle and wriggle her toes. We are hoping that by Friday (Phoebe's 14th birthday) she will be able to get out of bed and work on some more physio. She is working well with the team here and they are all really pleased with her progress so far - Phoebe is a strong and determined young lady and we are so very very proud of her.

We expect to be here for the next 10 days, and then a few days at home to rest before starting another intensive cycle of chemotherapy which will last for 18 weeks (with no delays).

Myself, Phoebe, Patricia and Kristian would like to say a huge 'THANK YOU' for the continued love, support and prayers of our parish family during this difficult time. You have given us the strength to get this far and we are truly blessed to have such amazing people in our lives."
